### Gurney Drive Hawker Centre

The #1 evening hawker scene. Arrive after 6pm for cendol, rojak, and char koay teow.

### Chulia Street Night Stalls

Backpacker strip by night transforms into a lively street food corridor. Try the nasi kandar.

### Kimberley Street

Heritage food street — Penang laksa, chendol, wonton mee. Best in the morning.

### Penang Road Famous Cendol

Queues since 1936. Pandan noodles, red beans, gula melaka syrup — the original.

### Air Itam Market

Local favourite for asam laksa. Less touristy, more authentic. Morning only.

### Batu Ferringhi Night Market

Beachside night market — souvenirs plus satay, grilled seafood, and fresh coconut.

### Pulau Tikus Market

Sunday morning wet market beloved by locals. Appam, nasi lemak, fresh durian stalls.

8

### New Lane Hawker Stalls

Open 6pm–midnight. The place for pasembur (Indian rojak) and fried oyster omelette.
